I believe that to stop (okay, reduce, we'll never completely stop) sexual assault, we need to further the efforts to make men understand preventing sexual assault is their responsibility.

That is a really big question! I think one of the most important areas is education and prevention. I fully support comprehensive, medically accurate, age-appropriate sex education, which research shows often delays sexual activity and increases contraceptive use. I also support the school-based health centers for Juneau students. I have participated in bystander training and believe it is important for intervention. Additionally, I believe that support for domestic violence/sexual assault shelters is vital. At the state level, Medicaid expansion is important for lower-income families to address some of these issues. Lastly, I think coordinated interventions among the school district, local agencies, law enforcement, health providers, and tribal entities are important to avoid fragmented delivery and identify voids in what is available.

Extremely important. In my adult life, I have watched the landscape of reproductive choice wither for all Americans. I regard reproductive choice is a human right and as one of the most fundamental components of gender equality, and I maintain unhesitating support for it. At a young age — far too young to be a responsible parent — my then-partner and I were able to access abortion services that would have been denied to our 21st century counterparts in many states. Many decades ago, my mother experienced a PROM early in her fourth pregnancy; at the time, she was able to receive immediate treatment that in many states today would face potentially life-threatening delays thanks to the consequences of the Dobbs decision. Though I would support reproductive choice even if these episodes were not part of my biography, they serve as a reminder that these rights are deeply personal for so many Americans.
