

Juneau Pro-Choice Coalition Scholarship Program



The Juneau Pro-Choice Coalition (JPCC) is committed to protecting access to safe and legal reproductive health services for all, including abortion. The purpose of the JPCC Scholarship Program is to support people who are devoted to these same reproductive self-determination values in pursuing higher education.

In 2023 the JPCC will award up to two \$1,500 merit-based scholarships on a competitive basis to applicants who have displayed a commitment to these values.

Eligibility:

JPCC scholarships are open to all Juneau high school seniors, university students, and adults working to further their formal education. Applications and supporting materials must be submitted to JPCC by April 10, 2023 on our website, juneauchoice.com.

Essay Prompt:

Please respond to the following prompt.

PROMPT: "Please explain how your experience, education, and/or activities contribute to you being a strong advocate for reproductive choice. This could include your most valued community commitments, academic achievements, and/or leadership activities. What and/or who motivated you to action? Imagine yourself five years from now; what will you be doing to positively impact reproductive rights?"

Responses may take the form of a written essay or video. Essays should be 300-600 words; videos should be between two and five minutes and must have a written script of the video essay submitted via the online application form (scripts need not meet the same essay length requirements).

Submit your essay or video script using the application form link (PART B) on the scholarship page of JPCC's website at juneauchoice.com. Video submissions may be either emailed directly to JPCC at juneauchoice@gmail.com, or you can email a link to a video hosting platform, such as YouTube, Vimeo, etc.
